- Requirements: License required.
- Speed Limit: 30 mph.

# **New York**

- Definition: Three-class system.
- Requirements: Helmet for Class 3 or under 18.
- Speed Limit: Class 1 & 2: 20 mph, Class 3: 25 mph.

# **North Carolina**

- Definition: Electric-assisted bicycle.
- Requirements: Min. age 16; no license.
- Speed Limit: 20 mph.

## **North Dakota**

- Definition: Motorized bicycle.
- Requirements: License; helmet under 18.
- Speed Limit: 30 mph.

## Ohio

- Definition: Three-class system.
- Requirements: Helmet for Class 3 under 18.

- Requirements: Helmet for Class 3; trail restrictions apply.
- Speed Limit: Class 1 & 2: 20 mph, Class 3: 28 mph.

# **West Virginia**

- Definition: Electric bicycle.

- Requirements: Helmet under 15.

- Speed Limit: 20 mph.

## Wisconsin

- Definition: Electric bicycle.

- Requirements: Three-class system.

- Speed Limit: Class 1 & 2: 20 mph, Class 3: 28 mph.

# **Wyoming**

- Definition: Electric bicycle.

- Requirements: Three-class system.

- Speed Limit: Class 1 & 2: 20 mph, Class 3: 28 mph.
